

Cyril Wecht, MD, JD, FCLM, received his MD from the University of Pittsburg and his JD from the University of Maryland. He is certified by the American Board of Pathology in anatomic, clinical and forensic pathology, and is a fellow of the College of American Pathologists, the American Society of Clinical Pathologists, and the National Association of Medical Examiners. Dr. Wecht is a charter diplomat of the American Board of Disaster Medicine and has served as vice chairman of that board. He is also a charter diplomat of the American Board of Legal Medicine and has served as chairman of the board.

Dr. Wecht was formerly the chairman of the Department of Pathology and president of the medical staff at St. Francis Central Hospital in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania. Dr. Wecht is a clinical professor at the University of Pittsburg School of Medicine and Graduate School of Public Health, an adjunct professor at Duquesne University School of Law, Pharmacy and Health Sciences, distinguished professor of anatomy and pathology at Carlow University, professor of law at Aristotle University School of Law and chairman of the advisory board of the Cyril H. Wecht Institute of Forensic Science and Law at Duquesne University School of Law.

Dr. Wecht is the author or co-author of 530 professional publications, and an editorial board member of 16 national and international medical-legal and forensic scientific publications. He has organized and conducted postgraduate medical-legal seminars in more than 50 countries. He has personally performed approximately 16,000 autopsies and has supervised, reviewed or been consulted on approximately 36,000 additional post-modern examinations. Dr. Wecht has testified in more than 1,000 criminal, civil and worker's compensation cases. He has appeared as a frequent guest of numerous national radio and TV programs discussing various medical-legal and forensic science subjects.
