

Marshall B. Kapp, JD, MPH, FCLM, is the Director of the Florida State University Center for Innovative Collaboration in Medicine and Law with a primary faculty appointment as Professor, Department of Geriatrics, FSU College of Medicine and secondary faculty appointments in the FSU College of Law and the Department of Medical Humanities and Social Sciences in the FSU College of Medicine. He also is associated with the FSU Pepper Institute on Aging and Public Policy. Kapp was the Garwin Distinguished Professor of Law and Medicine at Southern Illinois University Schools of Law and Medicine 2003-2009. He also is Professor Emeritus from Wright State University School of Medicine and served for over 20 years as a member of the adjunct faculty at the University of Dayton School of Law.

He is the current Editor of the American College of Legal Medicine's *Journal of Legal Medicine* and serves on the editorial boards of several other major journals in the health law field. He has published and spoken extensively on topics in health law, medical ethics, and law and aging.
