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Since completing her residency and fellowship training, Dr. McDowell has maintained a private practice in adult, adolescent and child psychiatry, as well as psychoanalysis. She also provides private clinical and medical-legal consultation and supervision. She is assistant clinical professor of psychiatry at UCLA and serves on the University of Kentucky School of Medicine Dean's Advisory Council. Her current interests include the complex interface between psychiatry and the law, as it relates to the expression of and the treatment of a wide range of psychopathology and legal sequelae.
