Present your research poster/abstract during our annual conference

CALL FOR POSTERS / ABSTRACTS

The **American College of Legal Medicine** (ACLM) will present the Basanta Award for the best original abstract or poster at its 2024 Annual Conference scheduled to take place at the **San Diego Hyatt Regency Mission Bay Hotel on March 1-3, 2024**.

All submitted posters will be displayed and presented during the conference.

College students, post-graduate students, young leaders (within the first 10 years of practice), current members, and Fellows are invited to present their research poster/abstract during our conference. A limited student travel fund is available for selected students in need who submit posters and travel to the conference site. Basanta Poster/Abstract Award Winners

- The winner of the abstract/poster competition will be awarded the Basanta Prize and \$500.00 in each of the three categories student, young professional, member/Fellow.
- Each winner will be given an opportunity to present their abstract/poster on stage at the conference (no longer than 10 minutes, please).
- Winners will also receive a complimentary one-year membership in the American College of Legal Medicine.
- All abstracts/posters will be evaluated for publication in *The Journal of Legal Medicine*.

Participation Criteria

- Posters and abstracts must be authored by a student, by a professional within the first 10 years of practice, or by a member/fellow of the ACLM, either alone or in collaboration with others.
- Posters and abstracts must be presented at the annual meeting in San Diego (students with demonstrated financial need may apply for a travel grant from the ACLM).
- No more than five posters will be accepted from a single, first author.

Format Instructions

- 1. All <u>posters</u> must be in PowerPoint with a 9" x 16" format and the information must fit on a single slide.
- 2. All <u>abstracts</u> must be in Word with standard letter size of 8 ¹/₂" x 11" with one-inch margins on all sides, in 12-point Arial font, and should not be more than two pages in length.
- 3. All posters and abstracts must list each author's name followed by their degrees, position, institution, city and state, and email address. If multiple authors are from the same institution,

their names, degrees, positions, and email addresses should be listed followed by the institution, city and state.

- 4. The title should be centered and boldfaced.
- 5. The authors are responsible for receiving permission to republish any copyright material such as a chart or figure.

Deadline for Submission

- * February 8, 2024 11:59 PM is the deadline for submission of posters and abstracts.

- Only posters and abstracts sent by email, submitted by the deadline, and in the requested format will be considered.

Judging

- All posters and abstracts will be judged by the Awards Committee based on originality, relevance, thoughtfulness of analysis, and quality of writing. The Committee's decisions are final and may not be appealed. Further, the Committee reserves the right not to award prizes if the entries do not meet the standards set by the Awards Committee.
- Posters that appear to be advertisements for a business or service or that endorses or promotes a product will not be accepted.
